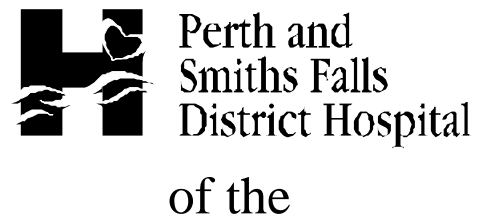

The purpose of your Community Chemotherapy Clinic is to provide chemotherapy to Perth, Smiths Falls and surrounding area cancer patients and to provide education and support to the cancer patient, family members and friends.

This clinic proudly offers bright and cheerful surroundings with a caring and supportive staff.

The Community Chemotherapy Clinic at the Perth and Smiths Falls District Hospital is a satellite of two cancer centres:

- < The Ottawa Hospital Regional Cancer Centre
- < Southeastern Ontario Cancer Centre at the Kingston General Hospital.

It is located on the 2nd floor at the GWM (Perth) Site.

The services provided to our communities include:

- Level 1 chemotherapy as per Cancer Care Ontario guidelines
- Communication with cancer centre Oncologists/nurses as required
- Venous Access Device support

Linkages with community agencies/services as required

Our clinic, which has been in operation for 5 years has been proudly decorated by a cancer survivor, Eleanor Lowery who continues to advocate for all cancer patients in the community. Her tireless promotion of fund-raising efforts has benefited the clinic space with furniture and equipment. Local Service clubs from both towns have also donated generously to equip this very pleasant, comfortable clinic.

Our clinic is staffed with qualified/ certified Registered Nurses experienced in Level 1 chemotherapy administration, symptom management, and ongoing support and counseling for our patients, maintaining the philosophy of “chemotherapy treatment close to home”. Four local general practitioners support the program and access the Ottawa or Kingston cancer centre Oncologists as required.
