Esther Green is Chief Nursing Officer and Director of Health Human Resource Planning, Cancer Care Ontario. She holds academic faculty appointments at the University of Toronto and McMaster University. Esther is the past President of the Canadian Association of Nurses in Oncology and is currently the President of the Canadian Association of Psychosocial Oncology.

Dr. Robert Buckman is a Medical Oncologist and an author. He is also Professor in the Department of Medicine at the University of Toronto and Adjunct Professor at the M.D. Anderson Cancer Center in Houston, Texas. Dr. Buckman specializes in breast cancer and teaches communication skills to physicians and nurses.

Dr. Ray Viola is a Palliative Care Physician at Kingston General Hospital (KGH). He is an Assistant Professor, Palliative Care Medicine Program Departments of Medicine, Family Medicine, Oncology, and Community Health and Epidemiology, Queen's University. A Career Scientist, his research focus is end-of-life health services.

Judith Gould is the Organizational Development Educator at KGH. She received a Master of Education from Queen's University with a specialization in adult learning. In 2005, she received the designation of Certified Training and Development Practitioner from the Canadian Society for Training and Development.
