

Regional Systemic Therapy Cancer Care

At the **Cancer Centre of Southeastern Ontario at Kingston General Hospital** Medical Oncologists, Oncology Nurses and Pharmacists provide a wide range of cancer treatment services such as chemotherapy, biotherapy, hormone therapy and supportive therapies.

However patients and their families would prefer to receive cancer treatment services as close to the homes as possible.

To support patients and their families the **Cancer Centre of Southeastern Ontario (KGH)** are developing a “**Regional Chemotherapy Closer to Home Program**” by way of formal affiliation agreements with regional partners.

When feasible chemotherapy and biotherapy will be administered at an affiliated site under the guidance of a local physician in collaboration with the Cancer Centre Medical Oncologist. To date our healthcare partners include the **Brockville General Hospital, Northumberland Hills Hospital, Perth/Smiths Falls District Hospital, Peterborough Regional Healthcare Centre** and the **St. Francis Memorial Hospital**. In circumstances where patients require complex chemotherapy, these treatments will be initiated and continued at the Cancer Centre until completion.
